



## Dennis Allen DUNN

March 15, 1952 - September 10, 2019

Dennis Allen Dunn of St. Charles, MO passed away Tuesday September 10, 2019 at the age of 67. He is preceded in death by his parents Robert Dunn and Cecilia Miller. He is survived by the love of his life Jean Audrey Arnold, his son Nicholas (wife Megan) Dunn, daughter Alicia Dunn, and grandsons Braxton and Chance Dunn.

Early in Dennis's career he enlisted in the United States Army on October 1969 in California. He was later stationed in Seoul, South Korea where he served 3 years as a helicopter pilot for several Generals. Dennis received several medals including Efficient Honor Fidelity, Army Commendation-Military Merit, National Defense Service, and Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal during his military career.

Dennis was well known in his work environment. Starting at a young age, he worked for his father doing construction. Soon after he progressed to the role of foundation foreman at McBride and Sons. He was known as a very hard worker, building the home where he raised his family, and rarely reached a stand-still on a project.

Dennis loved the outdoors, fishing, boating, and especially bow hunting. He enjoyed traveling with his wife during summer weekend float trips or to the lake. He was a very active man, he enjoyed building and fixing things for others, a real "jack of all trades." Some of Dennis' happiest days were spent sitting on his deck with his beautiful wife, his pug next to him, and a word search. He was a true family man; all he needed to be happy was to be around those he loved.
