Paul F. (Slim) Sebacher, 98, passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by family on Friday May 7, 2021.

He was born January 16, 1923 in Colwich, Kansas, the son of the late Alois Sebacher and Mathilda (Debrecht) Sebacher. He joined the U.S. Navy during WWII and served six war patrols on the submarine USS Picuda in the Pacific.
